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- ⁴⁷ Adequacy spending per pupil is \$3,540, plus adjustment for the Free and Reduced Lunch program and special education spending. The NH Department of Education confirmed that the average state spending per pupil is \$4,100.
- ⁴⁸ If the maximum 10 percent administration allowance is used (i.e. – \$0.4 million of the \$4 million maximum donations), there would be 1440 scholarships (\$3.6 million / \$2500 average scholarship). Since the average amount of the scholarships is mandated at \$2,500, the average amount spent per scholarship, including administration costs, would be \$2,500 * (\$0.4m/1440) = \$2,778.
- ⁴⁹ The maximum lost revenue in the first year is \$4 million * 0.935 = \$3.74 million. With 1,440 scholarships, the average loss in revenue per scholarship would be \$3.74 million / 1,440 = \$2,597.22.
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
